- FLOPPY DISK CONTROLLER CARD COMPATIBILITY NOTE -

The Deluxe Option Board will work reliably with nearly all IBM compatible machines and controller cards, however, customer reports have indicated the following:

- Installing the Deluxe Option Board in machines using a certain brand floppy disk controller card may disable the DOS FORMAT command. (Unfortunately, the cards that cause this failure have no brand name on them.) After installing the Deluxe Option Board in your machine use DOS to format a diskette in your floppy drive. If this fails (usually on track 0, side 0):
 - Be certain the PC/XT AT/COMPAQ jumper blocks (J4 and J5) are in the correct position. If they are not, the same symptom may occur.
 - If the Deluxe Option Board is correctly installed and you are experiencing this problem, you
 may return it to us with a copy of this notice. We will make a slight modification to your
 Deluxe Option Board which will allow it to work with your controller card.
 - Note: This should only occur with a very small percentage of floppy disk controller cards which follow a non-standard design.
- Due to a simple error during manufacturing, some Everex brand controller cards will not allow the installation of any card between the floppy disk drives and floppy disk controller card. Installation of the Deluxe Option Board will not interrupt normal operation of these machines, however, our board will fail to perform. Specifically, the copy process is immediately interrupted and the message "Check Diskette in Source Drive" will display on the screen.

Those experiencing this problem should contact the Return Authorization department at Everex, (415) 498-I 115. Everex is aware of this problem and are working on a correction to their floppy disk controller card.
