Caution: Before removing the cover of your computer, be sure to unplug your computer and all other options from their power source (wall outlet, power strip, etc.).

Remove the five screws from the back of your computer.

 \blacksquare Slide the cover forward then up.



IBM Portable Personal Computer

Caution: Before removing the cover of your computer, be sure to unplug your computer and all other options from their power source (wall outlet, power strip, etc.).

Remove the six screws from the front of your computer.



■Slide the cover toward the back and remove.







ADDS Model PC/I

Caution: Before removing the cover of your computer, be sure to unplug your computer and all other options from their power source (wall outlet, power strip, etc.).

■ Remove the five screws from the back of your computer.



■Slide the cover forward slightly, then lift straight up slowly. Connecting cables for the disk drive are attached directly to the cover and should not be removed.

Caution: Before removing the cover of your computer, be sure to unplug your computer and all other options from their power source (wall outlet, power strip, etc.).

Remove the two screws from the back of your computer.



■Slide the cover forward to release it from the chassis, then lift it off.

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■ Place the cover back on the chassis then slide it back.



■Replace the two screws.

Removing the Cover Caution: Before removing the cover of your computer, be sure to unplug your computer and all other options from their power source (wall outlet, power strip, etc.).

■ Facing the back of the computer, push gently inward on the cover above and to the right of the Compaq logo, then lift up.



■ A metal plate at the back of the computer covers the expansion slots. Remove the seven screws that hold in the plate and remove it.



Replacing the Cover

■ Put the metal plate back into place and replace the seven screws.



■ Insert the tabs on the back of the cover into the slots on the top of the chassis. Gently push down until the cover snaps shut.

Remove the five screws from the sides and the back of your computer.



Slide the cover forward, then lift it up and remove it.

■ Place the cover back on the chassis, then slide it back.

Remove the two screws from the back of your computer.



■Slide the cover toward the back slightly until the cover is released from the chassis, then lift it off.



Replacing the Cover

■ Lift the cover back onto the computer chassis. Fit the metal tabs on the bottom of the cover into the slots in the chassis. Slide the cover toward the front of the computer.
