Subject: Random Movement of Mouse Pointer on T1950CT

Random movement of the mouse pointer may occur on the T1950CT computer. This may be exhibited on a small number of units having 113 or 123 as the first three digits of the serial

No other units are affected. There are two forms the random movement may take:

- 1. When the Direct Connect Ballpoint Mouse (DCBP) version 2 (three-button mouse, marked ZA1051P02 or ZA1051P03) is connected to the T1950CT, the pointer may move randomly on the screen without any movement of the mouse ball.
- 2. Sometimes placing the pointer over an icon, results in the pointer jumping back to its original place.
