Dear Toshiba Service Providers and Customers,

BIOS version 5.40 has been released for the Tecra 700 series and is available on the Toshiba BBS [(714) 837-4408]. The new version affects the following changes from version 5.30.

- * A board revision compatibility issue that caused boot failures when connected to a Desk Station V (DS5) has been corrected.
- * The default HDD "Auto Power Down" option is set to 30 minutes. The "Disable" option has been eliminated.
- * The DS5 mounted Adaptec 3940 (AMD SCSI) will now be recognized and work at high speed.
- * Remote boot using the DE205 ISA Ethernet card is now available.
- * The cooling fan will run constantly any time the CD-ROM drive is mounted in the select bay. MaxTime will no longer turn the fan off when the CD-ROM drive is attached.
- * A cold boot problem where garbage was displayed during VGA initialization has been corrected.
- * The NEC MultiSync XV15 monitor will now be recognized consistently.
- * The error message that displays when the Tecra 700 is improperly attached to a desk station has been changed from "Attach" to "Attached."
