PROBLEM

- 1. The output to an external monitor is fuzzy at 1024x768 Resolution.
- 2. The Display Control 2.99 doesn't remember the right Refresh Rate on Boot.

SOLUTION

1. Refresh Rate is not set to something besides Interlaced in the Display Control 2.99 (C:\WINDOWS\SYSTEM\DSPCTL.EXE).

2. The wrong video driver is selected.

Solution:

- 1. Display Control 2.99 (C:\WINDOWS\SYSTEM\DSPCTL.EXE). Set refresh to something besides Interlaced.
- Choose Start/Settings/Display/Settings/Change Display Type/Adapter Type Choose - "Chips And Technologies, Accelerator (New)".
 The (New) driver is specifically designed to work with the Refresh Rate Setting.
