IDE & FDC USER'S MANUA

______ ______ FIDC (Floppy/Integrated Drive Controller) is a floppy and integrated/ embedded drive control card that can control up to two floppy (3½" or 5¼") and 2 integrated/embedded drive for PC/AT or Compatible computers.

Before installing this card, be sure the card's connector or jumper is set properly. The outline is shown below:





- JP1: IRQ14 line with or without buffer output. Some drive may need this line with buffer output, like COR-NER drive set 1-2 (factory set) without buffer output, set 2-3 with buffer output.
- JP2: High capacity drive rotate speed (RPM) select. Set 1-2 when 300 RPM drive is used set 2-3 (factory set) when 360 RPM drive is used.
- JP3, JP4: Hard disk/floppy drive primary/ secondary I/O address setting, see table shown below:
